New Business:

Ivan and Wayne presented our committee with 2 maps for Rural Communities

Map 1 - this map was for the St. Mary's LSD and did not pertain to discussions for our meeting.

Map 2 - this map covered a huge area from Route 104/105 junction up to the York/Carleton County line, the map chops of most of the LSD of Douglas.

Areas of loss would be

- Route 620 out to Stanley and the Sisson Mine area.
- Route 105 down to the City line and all side subdivisions.

We have asked to keep the boundary of the Fire Service and to give the Carlisle Road the option of where they would like to be and not just picked out and put in another area.

Local Government

- Is no longer looking at LSD Boundaries as possible Rural Communities.
- Only looking at communities of interest.
- Possibly use watersheds.
- Possibly use Fire Boundaries.
- Are not forcing this but LG will have a say on how big/small these communities will be.
- At some point, municipalities will be looked at to be incorporated into Rural Communities.

Discussions were held regarding the difficulties in forming a working group to get this off the ground.

Go forward:

- We will take this information out to the LSD for their input.
- We will speak with outlying LSD's for their input.
- Carlisle will need to be consulted and decide where they would like to be.
- Certainly when speaking with individuals, if they have an interest take their name and number for future information.
